Volunteer Appreciation: Our "Bright Light"

For the Michigan Democratic Party Legacy Dinner, each Congressional District was asked to submit names for who in their districts deserved a District Legacy Award. Nominees were submitted by county chairs and voted on at the district meeting. While the nominee for the Barry County Democratic Committee was not selected as a CD2 awardee, that person is certainly a winner as far as we are concerned! Read the write-up below that Chris Bush, with help from Elspeth Inglis, submitted for Michele Peltier:

Michele Peltier has been nominated to receive the MDP Legacy Award for CD2. Michele, originally from the area, moved to Barry County from the east side of the state after she and husband Ed retired. She became involved with the Barry County Democratic Committee in 2021 and soon became a fixture not only at the county party meetings but also at county, city, and school board meetings. Her interest in the workings of local government was quickly noticed, and she was soon appointed to serve on the county Planning Commission. Additionally, she wanted to understand the pulse of the county and took it upon herself to attend the Local

Government Accountability Forum (seen primarily as a support group for fans of Barry County's "constitutional sheriff"), sharing news and topics from that forum with Barry County Democrats. When asked what drove her to attend so many meetings, Michele shrugged and said, "It's fun."

Not only did Michele keep her ears and eyes open, she rolled up her sleeves and got to work: she volunteered with the local United Way office to help the elderly with their taxes; she hit the pavement whenever petitions needed signatures; she became a poll worker and also served as a precinct captain at the polls; and she joined the group seeking to pass a millage proposal to make improvements at Historic Charlton Park, a major public park, historic village and museum, and event venue in the county. One of the largest roles Michele took on was spearheading a letter-writing group, addressing our legislators on important issues and publishing in local, state, and national media outlets' editorial pages. She wrote templates so that others could use or modify her words and sign the letters themselves, thus amplifying our message. Her reputation of generating letter after letter led the MDP Rural Caucus to ask her to take charge of this effort with their members, so that letters from Democrats bombarded news outlets.

In late 2022/early 2023, Michele and Ed moved back to Oakland County to help her daughter with her newborn twins. While Barry County sorely misses them, we know they are right where they need to be. We hope others take to heart the words Michele shared when she was interviewed by the Hastings paper for their weekly "Bright Light" column: "I really believe people have to be involved if they're going to live someplace. You can't sit in isolation and do nothing or – I don't know – things collapse." While keeping up with her grandbabies might cause her to collapse, we feel that Michele will continue to stand tall and use her energies to promote the Democratic Party.

The CD2 awardees were Peggy Raddatz, long-serving Secretary of the District and Manistee County, and Dallas Dean, a very dedicated fixture as District and Newaygo County Treasurer. Congratulations to all the nominees and much gratitude for your service to the Party!
